Many of us participated in the archdiocesan survey for the global synod during January and February of 2022. Archbishop Zinkula has reviewed the synod report generated by 16,000 household responses. The **DMI survey** is the next step in a process that will lead to new mission and vision statements, and pastoral priorities.
